



# Inclement Weather Procedures

As we anticipate the first 'big chill' of the winter, we want to remind you of Scotland County Schools' inclement weather procedures.

During severe weather watches or warnings, our school system works with the National Weather Service and local authorities to monitor conditions and proceeds with arrival and dismissal based upon known conditions. Adjustments are made as needed. Automated phone calls, postings to SCS social media pages, and notification to the local media will be made by 6:00 am. As always, student and staff safety will be at the forefront in the decision making process.
